## Brewerton Elementary PTO Meeting Minutes October 12, 2022

## 1. PRINCIPAL'S REPORT

- a. Math facts challenge- Math facts are critical to know, the basis for everything, they need to be memorized. Mr. Bowden has challenged the 4th and 5th graders to get 100 multiplication facts (12x12) correct in 5 minutes or less. The top 5 students who show growth in each class every month from Sept-Jan will go on Mr. Bowden's Wall of Fame in the cafeteria. Those kids will be part of a pizza party. Kids who pass the test in under 5 minutes will also get their name on the Wall of Fame and go to McDonalds for lunch. He already took 7 -4th graders and 13 -5th graders last week. If students improve to 4 minutes and 3 minutes they will be able to go again. These tests are done on the chromebook, thatquiz.org. New kids are added to the list almost every day, seeing a lot of pride and growth. Math facts challenge will also go into 3rd grade at the teachers' request after Christmas (multiplication 10x10)
- **b.** Fire Safety Day- Thursday 10/14/22 around 9:20 am. Fire trucks will be here first thing in the morning. First time having this since before COVID. Fire drill to go outside to see the firetrucks and listen to the firemen. Firefighters will also go inside to visit the classrooms.
- **c. Fall Picture Day-** 10/26/22. A flyer went home with the code and information for how to order. Orders are online. You can request paper ordering from Mrs. Hampson.
- d. Halloween Parade- Text blast was sent out with a link to document with information. Parade route will be through the parking lot and around the front of the school. Parents can pick up kids afterwards using pikmykid. There will also be a regular ½ day dismissal.
- 2. Wayne Chapman- Supervisor for Boy Scout Pack 112. Pack was overseen by a charter organization which is our PTO. Since Covid there have been no meetings, the pack dissolved and there has been interest to start back up. He has been hanging onto assets. Assets include fundraising money in a bank account (\$1,436.52), aluminum pinewood derby tracks, 10 totes with various materials (compasses, ropes, sleeping bags, etc).
