## 1. PRINCIPAL'S REPORT

## 3. Superintendent Parent Council (SPC) meeting

- a. Arts in Education Mr. Will Jones with CiTi BOCES spoke on Arts in Education which is a state program that focuses on art enrichment within the school. The program includes Summer Enrichment Programs which are starting up again. Anything related to the arts, try to run through Arts in Education to build the amount up. The school receives about 80% of the expense returned as funding to be used in the next school year. Keep in mind it is a "use it or lose it" policy. Examples of things that can be approved through the program are admission fees, tickets, speakers, etc. Things that are not covered are buses, hotels and food. Get requests in as early as possible.
- **b.** Strategic Planning Committee. Meeting is scheduled for Wednesday November 30<sup>th</sup> from 6:30pm-8pm. Go over the strategic plan and other committees.
