## 1. PRINCIPAL'S REPORT

- a. Volunteers must fill out the form on the CSSD website and go through the sex offender list. If you have filled out the form previously, your name was run through the system over the summer. You can email Mrs. Hampson to double check that you are still approved to volunteer.
- b. Schooltool has a new URL.
- **c.** We are serving about 90 breakfasts a day. It is a cold breakfast in a bag. Students get off the bus when it arrives at school and head to the cafeteria. TAs help the younger students with opening cereal and pouring milk. They mark down who is receiving breakfast so it can be recorded in individual accounts.
- **d.** The math fact challenge will be started in 4th grade with some minor adjustments. 5th grade will not be doing it again.
- **e.** We have been following and using the science of reading to help students with decoding words. If they can decode and read a nonsense word, then this will help them read longer words. At the end of last year, 90% of kindergarten students were reading on grade level and 94% of 1st grade students were reading on grade level.
