Traffic Pattern Update

Dear Parents and Guardians:

We hope your summer is going well and you are getting to enjoy the central New York weather. Our capital project construction here at Paul V. Moore High School is progressing and we anticipate the majority of the work will be completed prior to the start of the school year. With student safety at the forefront of our thoughts, please review the following updates:

- The student drop off/pick up loop from Route 12 (Caughdenoy Road) will be utilized for all parents and guardians dropping off students in the morning and/or picking students up in the afternoon*. Drivers will enter from Route 12, proceed through the loop, and exit via Route 12.
- For safety reasons, students will enter the building at the main entrance/single point of entry. The doors on the Route 12 side of the building will not be open for entrance. The drop off point is at the end of the building, closest to the student parking lot. Students will then walk alongside the bus loop to the main entrance and enter the building.
- To avoid congestion with the buses, we will keep the entrance to the student parking lot as a one way entrance from Route 12. Those exiting the student parking lot will exit toward Tucker Avenue.
- Please note the new signage directing traffic into and out of the loop and parking areas.

As with any change, this new pattern might take some time for us to become acclimated. Please see the diagram below. If you have any questions or concerns, please do not hesitate to contact us.
