FUN FACTS

Transportation aid is paid on general operations and on bus purchases.

- All school districts are entitled to
 transportation aid, between 6.5% and 90%
 of their approved transportation expenses.
- Central Square is a 88.7% aid District.



BUS PURCHASES

- Districts must obtain voter approval for all bus purchases.
- District bus purchases must also be approved by SED in order to generate Transportation Aid.
- The net approved cost of each school bus is now aided according to an assumed amortization schedule of five (5) years established by the SED.
- Aid will be paid based upon two equal assumed semiannual payments of principal and interest using a statewide average interest rate.
 - Aid begins 12 months after the purchase order date and will be calculated based upon the assumed debt service payments.
